Cricket Australia strongly recommends that all junior and senior community players wear British Standard 7928:2013 compliant helmets from the 2019/20 season.

Key Features:

- Better construction, meaning a ball won't squeeze between the peak and grille of the helmet.
- Better design and strength of materials, meaning the ball won't pull the grille into your face.
- And greater coverage of the occipital area (behind the ear) to provide increased protection.

Consistent with Cricket Australia's commitment to player safety and an ICC directive in 2015, it is mandatory for Cricket Australia, State Contracted cricketers and players in CA Pathway competitions in Australia to wear helmets that are compliant with British Standard 7928:2013 when batting, wicket keeping up to the stumps and fielding in close to the batter.
